Tax rebate

Many thanks to the PAYE tax payers who signed and returned the form they received from the parish about their 2011 donations to the parish. This has allowed the parish to reclaim some of the tax they paid and put it towards the building fund debt. So far, the parish has reclaimed over €12,000.
