Vatican II – 50 years later

This week in 1962, Pope John XXIII convened what was to become known as the Second Vatican Council (or Vatican II). It was a gathering of the bishops of the world to pray, discuss and provide leadership around how the Catholic Church would develop “in the modern world”. The Council and the documents it produced are a milestone in the history of our faith community.

This week, on the 50th anniversary, Pope Benedict (who was present at the Council in 1962) has convened a Synod of Bishops to mark the anniversary and also to discuss the important question of how to express our faith as followers of Christ. He is launching what he has called a “Year of Faith”.

YEAR OF FAITH 2012 2013

The logo for the Year of Faith is composed of a square, bordered field on which a boat, symbolizing the Church, is represented as sailing on waves. The main mast of the boat is a cross from which sails are displayed in the form of dynamic signs which compose the three letters that symbolise Christ (IHS). The background to the sails is a sun which, associated with the IHS, refers also to the Eucharist.
