First Holy Communion 2013

Parents of boys and girls in the four schools of the parish and the parents of one home-schooled boy will be presenting their children to prepare for their First Holy Communion which they receive in May 2013. At the baptism of the children, the parents and godparents promised to help the children come to know Jesus as they grow up and they undertook to help them develop their faith and be included in the life of the local Church community. Receiving Jesus at Holy Communion is the most important step the children will take in their spiritual lives. The preparation of the children for this step in their lives is done as partnership between the parents, the school and the parish community. The dates of the Masses at which the children will receive for the first time are as follows:-

Sat May 4th at Castletown Church
Sat May 11th at Enniskeane Church
Sat May 25th at Ahiohill Church While the First Holy Communion Masses are separate, the parish preparation towards those dates will be done centrally. Families will be invited in November to participate in the "Do This in Memory" parish programme which will begin with an enrolment ceremony on Sunday Nov 25th. The enrolment and the DTIM programme will be held in Enniskeane church at one Sunday Mass each month during the year.

November Holy Souls Novena

During November, we pray for our loved ones, neighbours, friends and parishioners who have died. We remember them, thank God for them and ask God to fulfil the promise made by Jesus that "whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have eternal life".

Beginning on Nov 2nd, all the Masses in the parish for nine days (a novena) will be offered for the people who are enrolled in our annual novena. Envelopes are available in the churches for this purpose. Please include a list of the names of your loved ones and an offering and return the envelope before Nov 2nd.

On the evening of Nov 9th, the Mass will include special prayers for people whose funerals have taken place in our parish since this time last year. The Novena concludes with the 7.30pm Mass in Enniskeane on Nov 10th.
