Getting tax back

If someone in your household pays tax through the PAYE system (i.e. it's deducted from the pay-check) that person will have paid income tax on their wages in 2012 – including on the money that they later put into the church collections. But with the help of parishioners who are PAYE earners, the parish can be refunded that tax. Many thanks to the parishioners who have already sent back the form for this that went out with the receipts to the people who use the parish envelopes.

The form only applies where a person only pays PAYE income tax and has no other tax to pay. (People who are self-employed claim relief on their donations by giving the receipt to whoever completes their tax return).
