The parish accounts are reviewed regularly by the parish finance committee and independently certified by FDC Accountants, Bandon.

Getting tax credit for your parish donations

Parishioners who pay income tax are not required to pay tax on the money they donate to the parish (or to any charity) provided they meet a few conditions, e.g. the total of the donations in one year must be $\[mathebox{\ensuremath{\in}} 250$ or more. The parish records each donation confidentially and provides the parishioners with a receipt at year end. To do this, a parishioner needs to use the parish's numbered envelopes for each collection.

Any parishioner who doesn't have a set of envelopes but wishes to have one is asked to contact Fr. Hayes or the parish office at (023) 8847769.

t is a tribute to the people of the parish and to all who support the parish that the repayments on the parish debt have been maintained in the past year and we are making progress in reducing the debt.

During 2012, we also undertook a significant investment in the parish church at Enniskeane with the installation of the pipe organ which came from Clonakilty's Mercy Convent. The installation required a reinforcing of the choir gallery as well as a refitting of the gallery floor. It was also opportune to rebuild the gallery stairs so that it all conforms to safety standards. This extra work added a lot to the costs but it is all now finished and will be a "job for life".

At the start of 2012 the parish building fund debt stood at \in 145,413. During 2012, the monthly collections, fundraising events and donations helped bring the debt at the bank down to \in 67,277 by the end of the year.

Some of the bills due on the organ installation were not in by the end of the year so our repayment of the building fund debt in 2013 will be less so that we can also clear the organ and gallery bills.

Because donations given to charities are not taxed, we were able to again reclaim tax this year from Revenue for donations of PAYE parishioners. This amounted to &14,116 (up from last year's &11,778).

In order for this to work well for everybody, it's important to keep using the envelopes. As always, the privacy of parishioners' donations is carefully respected and secured.

Thanks to the use of the special parish envelopes, the contributions of parishioners who attend Mass in other parishes make their way back to this parish and we are grateful to all who distribute the envelopes and to those who use them.

Many parishioners are not liable for income tax and don't use envelopes. Their donations to parish collections are also appreciated.

The parish accounts do not include people's financial support for the clergy. The clergy receive their livelihood from twice-yearly Station Dues, Easter and Christmas Offerings, offerings for officiating at Sacraments and one Mass offering per day. Thank You.
