Many thanks to all the people who cooperate with cleaning and maintaining our parish cemeteries. They are a reflection of the esteem in which we hold our departed family members, neighbours and former parishioners. The large attendance at our recent Masses for those buried in our cemeteries is further testament of how we value our connections with the people who have gone before us.

Many people adorn their family graves with tributes which range from flowers and wreaths to statuettes, etc. Some are permanent, some only last a certain time and then need to be removed. The parish does not have a facility for disposing of these so we kindly ask that people take these items away with them rather than letting them become debris in the cemeteries. Plastics can be recycled and decayed flowers can be composted. In this way we can continue to keep our parish cemeteries in a dignified state that befits the memory of all who are buried in these sacred places. May they rest in peace.
