Roads to Ordination.

Two groups of people in our diocese are on different roads but, with the help of God, both roads lead to the Sacrament of Holy Orders (or Ordination).

Bishop Buckley has confirmed that we have six student priests now who have commenced college again this year. They are at different stages of the seven-year programme. One will be ordained a priest next year at the Cathedral in Cork; another will be ordained a deacon.

Earlier this year, Bishop Buckley invited applicants to the Permanent Diaconate - a ministry that includes married men giving part-time service to the church. Six men have responded and begin their preparation programme this year. Later this month, Bishop Buckley will ask us all to help pay the costs of these training programmes and college fees but let us also remember these men in prayer. And let us ask the Lord to help more people answer his call to serve in his vineyard.
