## Fr Con White RIP

The death has occurred in Nazareth House, Mallow, of Fr. Con White, former parish priest of Carrignavar and a native of Carhuvouler in Enniskeane Parish.

Fr. Con was ordained a priest of the Cork diocese in 1956.

After ordination, he taught at St. Finbarr's College, Farranferris, until 1970 when he served as curate at Carrignavar for nine years. In 1979 he moved to the Cathedral parish which then included most of the north-west side of the city, including Knocknaheeny and Hollyhill which Fr. Con ministered in. When the Knocknaheeny area became its own parish in 1981, Fr. Con was appointed as its first parish priest and he served there until 1984 when he was appointed parish priest of Blackrock and the new Mahon area. He moved to Carrignavar for a second appointment in 1994 – this time as parish priest – where he served until he retired in 2006. May he rest in the peace of the Lord whom he served.

## Holy Communion enrolment

Children celebrating the Sacrament of Penance for the first time in the Spring and receiving their First Holy Communion in May will be enrolled at the 12noon Mass in Enniskeane Church on Sunday Nov 3rd. It will also mark the beginning of the parish's Do This in Memory programme this year involving the children and their families more in Sunday Mass.

## November Novena

The nine days of Masses for the souls of our departed loved ones and parishioners will be offered between Nov 2nd and Nov 10th. You are invited to enrol your loved ones in the Novena by placing their names and an offering in an envelope and returning it to the church. During the Novena, there will be Mass Mon to Thurs at 10am in Enniskeane, 7.30pm in Castletown Kenneigh and 8.30pm in Ahihill. The weekend Masses are also part of the Novena. On Fri 8th at Enniskeane Church at 7.30pm the whole parish comes together, with the families who are bereaved this year, to remember and pray for those who have died in the past year.
