November Novena

The nine days of Masses for the souls of our departed loved ones and parishioners will be offered between Nov 2nd and Nov 10th. You are invited to enrol your loved ones in the Novena by placing their names and an offering in an envelope and returning it to the church. During the Novena, there will be Mass Mon to Thurs at 10am in Enniskeane, 7.30pm in Castletown Kenneigh and 8.30pm in Ahiohill. The weekend Masses are also part of the Novena. On Fri 8th at Enniskeane Church at 7.30pm the whole parish comes together, with the families who are bereaved this year, to remember and pray for those who have died in the past year.

Booking Masses

At the Parish Office in the Parochial House (see hours below) people can hand in names of people they want prayed for at weekend Masses in the parish. A Mass can also be booked to be offered for a specific anniversary or private intention on weekdays and weekends. (First preference for weekend Masses is given to Month's Mind masses, and first and second anniversaries.) Mass cards can also be signed and the relevant Mass booked to be offered later.

All Saints Day

Friday Nov 1st is the Feast of All Saints and a holyday of obligation. Mass in Enniskeane Church at 10.30am and at 7.30pm.

It would surely be a pity if we paid more attention to the pagan rituals of Halloween (with symbols of death and fear) than we do to thanking God for the blessing and help of all the saints (with symbols of hope and new life).

All Souls Day

On November 2nd, the prayers of the church are directed to God for the souls of our loved ones and parishioners who have died. Our faith teaches us that "it is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead". Mass will be celebrated in Enniskeane Church on Saturday 2nd at 11am to begin our Novena of Masses for the Holy Souls.
