He is the author of many books including: Why Go to Church?; Taking the Plunge; What is the point of being a Christian?; I call you friends - to name but a few. When are they going to bring us more priests from Africa or South America? A question often asked when discussing the declining number of priests in Ireland. Answer: average number of Catholics for each priest in Africa in 2012: 4,938. In the Americas: 4,871. And in Europe: 1,538 Catholics per priest. (Vatican Statistics for 2012.)
