## Church Care Committees

Over the next few weeks we will set up  
a small committee of people to help take  
care of the ongoing maintenance of our  
three churches. Attending to the small  
problems that may arise from time to  
time is better than letting things build up  
into bigger problems. It is also true to  
say that it is better to have a few parish-  
ioners keep an eye on things and to work  
with the priest and the Parish Finance  
Committee.

Each church will have a group of five  
people. Three will be elected by parish-  
ioners; two will be nominated by the  
parish priest and the Parish Finance  
Committee. After each group is estab-  
lished, they will name one member to at-  
tend the parish finance committee  
meetings and report on any issues that  
arise. The church care committee will al-  
ways account to the parish finance com-  
mittee which also works with the parish  
priest.

committees will be done at Mass on the  
weekend of May 31st/June 1st
