Message from Bishop Buckley

"I write to bring to your attention the annual Collection for the Education of Students to the Priesthood which takes place on 27th/28th Sept.

The Diocese is fortunate in having two priestly Ordinations this year. Fr Ben Hodnett was ordained in June and Rev Marius O'Reilly will be ordained to Priesthood on the Feast of Christ the King in November. In addition, we have one further Clerical student in the Irish College in Rome and three students in Maynooth. The cost of educating each student for the Priesthood can be as much as €30,000.

The Diocese also has a number of men in training for the Permanent Diaconate. Two, having completed the preparatory year, are now commencing formal studies and another has begun the preparatory year. While this development is good news, it does have financial implications. This collection is the principal source of funding for the education of our clerical students. The collection has also been used to subvent a number of lay people from the Diocese who are involved in their parishes and are studing Theology as well as funding some further study for priests."
