Taxing month

Parishioners who support the parish fi-
nancially and who pay income tax on
their earnings (either as PAYE or as a
self-employed person) can have some of
that tax put to use locally.

All our taxes stay with the government
unless we decide where they can be
used. By returning a simple form to the
parish, you are ensuring that some of
your hard-earned wages and income tax
are used locally to maintain our church
buildings, to help pay parish bills for
electricity, heating oil and gas, water, in-
surance, wages, and other day to day
costs of the parish. (Clergy income is
completely separate from this.)

Many thanks to the more than 130
households that have already returned
the form which was posted out earlier
this year.

If you used the numbered envelopes
last year and you would like to have
some of your income tax put to good use
in the local parish, and you have lost the
form that was posted out, you can down-
load the form from the parish website at
www.enniskeaneparish.ie

The parish doesn't need to know any-
thing about your personal business or
tax. That's private. You only give the
parish your PPS number and your per-
mission to get some of your tax back.
