Supporting third-level students

Life in third-level colleges is very different to school! There are many opportunities, many challenges and many pressures. The Catholic Church has been a long-time supporter of students in colleges and other institutes through what is known as the college chaplaincies. The chaplaincies are staffed by teams of people that may include lay people, priests and religious sisters.
