#### Church works

During the past two weeks, the heating systems in Enniskeane and Castletown Kinneigh Churches have had work down to them to improve their efficiency. The pipe work and radiators in Castletown are old and had accumulated a lot of sediment and sludge which was preventing some radiators from working and reducing the heat output overall. This sludge has now been removed from the entire system and all the radiators are working again. The radiators are old and many of the valves are worn. Parishioners are asked to not turn the radiator valves as this will only increase the chance of they leaking. At Enniskeane church, the flow of hot water from the boiler house to the church has been improved. This has included adding a new more powerful circulation pump and by changing some valves and by removing others. An extra radiator has also been added in the sanctuary to reduce the circulation of cold air. The total cost is estimated at just over €9,000 including VAT. (Both systems should now burn less heating oil and still provide better heat.)
