40th Padre Pio Mass

This year is the fortieth anniversary of the parish's first Padre Pio Mass which is celebrated annually to mark St. Padre Pio's birthday on May 25th. This year, the Mass will be held on the day itself, ie Monday May 25th at 7.30pm. The principal celebrants will be Capuchin Friars from Cork. They will bless people with Padre Pio's relics beginning at 6pm until Mass time, and again after Mass.

Corpus Christi Procession

The annual parish Procession with the Blessed Sacrament takes place on the Feast of the Body & Blood of Christi (Corpus Christi) which this year falls on Sunday June 7th. The procession begins immediately after 12noon Mass in Enniskeane and follows the same route as in recent years — ending in Gort Mhuire with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

The participation of all parishioners of all ages is encouraged, especially the children who have recently received their First Holy Communion. The Parish Assembly is coordinating the procession with help from many others. After the procession, an ice-cream stall will be provided with all proceeds going to Down Syndrome Ireland. Refreshments will also be served in the Gort Mhuire centre (baking will be welcomed before Mass).
