Parish Funds update

This is a summary of how our parish's finances stood at the end of last year (2014) according to our finalised accounts.

The accounts show that our parishioners continue to be generous in their support for the financial needs of the parish.

The ordinary Sunday and holyday collections amounted to \in 115,469 for the year (\in 114,910 in 2013). The Building Fund collections and donations came to \in 51,152 (\in 57,310 in 2013). Donations and bequests came to \in 8,975 (32,622 in 2013). Other smaller items along with \in 12,869 which was raised in the Special collections brought the total income to \in 213,476.

Out of that, we contributed just over €26,000 to the diocese in levies and collections for the running of the diocese and for the fund that cares for retired and sick priests. The Special Collections income (€12,869) is then sent along to the recipients like the Lourdes Fund, the Holy Places, etc. There was €44,137 spent on maintenance and repairs in the three churches (including €10,398 to improve the heating in Enniskeane and Castletown). Insurance cost €9,543 and Light and Heat for the three churches cost €13,602 (€14,619 in 2013). Wages, PRSI and USC for three employees came to €16,343 (€14,442 in 2013). The

total resources expended in 2014 comes to €153,914.

There was a difference between income and expenditure for the year of $\[mathebox{}{\in}59,562$ which is just slightly more than the Building Fund Income which is being set aside for maintenance of the churches. (There was a surplus of income over expenditure for 2013 of $\[mathebox{}{\in}37,287$ -- most of this was used to pay off the loan).

We began 2013 with \in 12,729 in the bank and we finished the year with \in 72,256 (which includes the building fund reserve).

[Due to a change made by the Government to the way the rebate of income tax is made to charities, the money due to be paid to the parish by Revenue for 2013 was not refunded in 2014 but has been paid in the first half of 2015. In effect, the closing balance for 2014 would otherwise have been about €25,000 extra as many more of our parishioners who pay income tax have now authorised the parish to claim back some of the tax.]

Many thanks to all who contribute to the parish funds and also to everyone who contributes dues and offerings for the clergy.
