It's our parish's turn to host the Community Carol Service this year — where will the hospitality and tea come from? What new things should we start planning to build up our faith in God?

Finding answers to these important questions, and many more, will be the agenda for the meetings of the new Parish Assembly this month. But first: who is in the Assembly?
