### **Holy Souls Novena**

Time is changing, leaves are falling, nights are getting longer. Nature is preparing for winter.

The human journey is also shaped by our preparation for our own autumn – when our own days shorten and we face our mortality.

In November each year we pray in a special way for our people who have died — we pray for them all together as one great gathering of souls.

From Nov 2nd to Nov 10th, all the Masses in the parish's three churches are offered by the priests for people who have died — the 'holy souls'. You are invited to enrol your own people in this nine days of Masses (a novena) by writing their names on a piece of paper and placing it with an offering in an envelope which you are asked to return to the church before Nov 2nd. (Envelopes are available at the churches also.)

During the Novena, from Tues Nov 2nd to Fri Nov 6th and on Mon Nov 9th, Masses are at 10am in Enniskeane, 7.30pm in Castletown Kinneigh and at 8.30pm in Ahiohill; the weekend Masses on Nov 7/8th are also part of the Novena. On Tues 10th, the Novena concludes with a parish Mass at 7.30pm in Enniskeane in which we also remember in a particular way the people whose funerals have taken place in our parish in the past year.

#### **Methodist Hall**

The Methodist community at Ballineen celebrates the dedication of their new hall on Fri 30th Oct at 8 pm. The speaker will be Rev Bill Mullally, who was a minister in this area many years ago. They have issued an open invitation to the service and refreshments afterwards.

We have 35 new altar servers who have signed up to serve God and his people in our parish at Mass. They will all begin their service in coming weeks.
