Taxing time

For all who are self-assessed tax payers, these weeks are a drain on funds! No doubt a lot of money has left the parish in the past month on its way to Revenue and Government in Dublin. 146 of the households in our parish have made it possible to get some of their taxes back from Dublin and put it to use in the parish. Parishioners who contribute to the parish collections shouldn't have to pay tax on that money. A simple form (available on the parish website in the downloads section) just needs the parishioner's PPS number and their signature to authorise the parish to get some of the tax back. If you sent back the form already, thanks. It only needs to be updated once every five years.

In recent months, Revenue have refunded €13,807.88 of tax paid last year by parishioners. If you would like to have some of your income tax put to use locally and have not sent back the form, you can download it at
