Enniskeane Church cleaning

There are dedicated people across the parish who keep our churches clean and tidy each week and we are grateful to them. However, they cannot clean areas of the church that are out of reach. Because this involves bringing in special heists and other equipment, as well as moving the pews, the church will be closed from the morning of Monday Feb 22nd until the morning of Sat Feb 27th. Volunteer Missionary Movement

VMM is an international lay Catholic Missionary organisation founded in 1969. VMM recruits, trains and supports skilled volunteers with professional or technical expertise to work in areas of need in Africa, Asia and Latin America. Currently they are supporting more than 50 volunteers in 10 countries on a variety of missionary and development programmes.
