

#### Fr Sean McCarthy RIP

In June 1983, Bantry native, Fr Sean McCarthy was appointed PP of this parish and began a special connection with this parish and its people. In the intervening 32 years, he has been a Christlike shepherd and admired in return for his faith, his enjoyment of people's company and his gentle guiding of the parish.

He will be especially remembered for his commitment to the Station Masses, the pilgrimages to Lourdes, the twinning-trips to France, and his support of the four parish schools — to the point of serving on one of the school boards until just last year!

Fr Sean was blessed to be able to live independently into his 93rd year and to be able to continue to live among the community about which he cared so much. This week, he has been called to his eternal home "a home not built by human hands, in the heavens".

Fr Sean was ordained a priest in Maynooth on June 18, 1949 along with Bishop Michael Murphy; Fr. Frank Murphy, who died as PP Kilmichael, and Fr Jim Coombes who died in Timoleague.

They were ordained in an Ireland where there was no room for them because the country had too many priests. So Fr Sean's first parish was St Jerome's parish in Hyattsville, Maryland, just outside Washington DC. where he served for six years.

In 1955, Fr Sean was called home to his first appointment in Cork as Chaplain to St. Maries of the Isle Convent, in the heart of Cork city, and assistant curate in the South Parish. There followed terms in Crosshaven, Our Lady's Hospital as Chaplain, Passage West and back to the South Parish as curate in the 70s, followed by a short time in Turner's Cross in the early 80s before he came to Enniskeane.

It was his wish that he be laid to rest beside the church where he has offered Mass so often. We ask the Lord to give him a kindly welcome home. May he rest in peace.
