Envelope bother!

Using the weekly parish envelopes for collections can be a nuisance at times! And it involves a good amount of work by the parish office, parish assembly members and others to coordinate the delivery of the boxes to homes. Then each week, we have a very efficient and anonymous system in the parish where the amount in each envelope is recorded and logged in a computer. At year end, we can send a claim to the Revenue whereby the parish gets back some of the income tax donated by people who support the parish. (The parish never knows anything about the person involved.) Gradually, over the year, Revenue lodge money to the parish account.

For the year Jan to Dec 2014, we have received back from Revenue €25,009.25 of parishioners' income taxes. The boxes might be a nuisance but this money is now at the disposal of the parish! Thanks to all involved.
