# **Parish Finances**

Some key points from an overview of our financial report for last year:-

Weekend and holiday offertory collections declined 8% compared with the previous year [106,287 in 2015; 115,469 in 2014]

The Building Fund collections during 2015 came to  $\notin$  35,960 while in 2013 it was  $\notin$  51,152.

However, the total income of the parish for the year [269,267 in 2015 and 213,475] increased.  $\notin$ 25,000 of the difference is down to the tax-back refund for 2013 which was refunded in 2015 along with the refund for 2014. There were also some extra donations given to the parish during the year, for which we are very grateful.

On the expenditure side, we continue to operate a prudent budget and our outgo-

ings are more or less in line with previous years — when a few once-off items are taken into account: €145, 572 in 2015 compared with €153,914 in 2014.

This means that in 2015, we had a surplus of resources over expenditure of  $\notin 123,694$  — compared with  $\notin 59,561$  in the previous year. Income refunded to the parish and extra donations are the principal difference, along with less expenditure on maintenance in that year.

During the next year or so, we have plans to renovate the church at Castletown Kinneigh along with works in Ahiohill cemetery and Enniskeane church yard. So our savings will be depleted quickly but our parishioners and supporters continue to be very generous towards the parish and there's no doubt but that this will continue to be the case.
