We wish the boys in green well today in France while we all eat our Lyonnais potatoes! One of the positives for the fans on the road following them will be a visit to the lovely city of Lyon.

Among its connections with these parts is that it holds the mortal remains of a Cork bishop! John O'Brien born in 1701 in Glanworth. He studied for the priesthood in Toulouse. He returned to Ireland in 1738 and became PP of Castlelyons. He was Bishop of Cloyne and Ross during Penal times. He died in exile in Lyon in 1769 and was interred at the Church St. Martin, at Place d'Ainay, in the heart of Lyon.

High over the city of Lyon is the basilica of Notre Dame de Fourvier which was built by the people of Lyon after they were spared from a plague. Today, maybe the man to pray to for a good outcome is an O'Brien from Co Cork!
