Support of future priests

Currently, there are six people in training to become priests to serve in the 68 parishes of our diocese. One of these is a Deacon now and in his final year of preparation for priesthood. Three began their studies at St. Patrick's College, Maynooth, this year.

Their biggest challenge during their time in seminary is figuring out if this is what the Lord is calling them to do with their lives. Our prayer support can help. A recent poster I saw says “No one is born a priest!” So each of us can also support people who are thinking about whether the Lord may be calling them to priesthood. We can encourage people to think about it positively.

The seminarians also need our financial support as the diocese meets all the costs of seminary formation for our students: accommodation, meals, academic fees, books, etc.

The second collection at Masses this weekend is for the Priesthood Education Fund. Fees paid to Maynooth last year were €88,500 while the annual collection came to €72,015. Your support in prayer, encouragement and funds is much appreciated.
