World Missions Ireland, the working title of the four Pontifical mission societies, organises the Mission Sunday collection in all Churches nationwide.

Mission Sunday falls on the 23rd October. Our theme is 'Every Christian is a Missionary'. We can all do our part in an open, joyful and generous way.

Nano Nagle

Nano Nagle, foundress of the Presentation Sisters, was made Venerable by Pope Francis in 2012. Since then we are actively encouraging prayer for a miracle which is required for her canonisation.

Nano set up several hedge schools in Cork in the 1700's at a time when Catholic education was forbidden. She was a pioneer of Catholic education.

She founded the Presentation Congregation on Christmas eve in 1775, in South Presentation Convent. There she continued to work tirelessly until her death in 1784. She was fondly known as 'The Lady of the Lantern' due to the fact that was regularly seen moving through the streets at night visiting the old and lonely.

It is hoped that Pope Francis will visit Ireland in 2018 for the 9th World Meeting of Families. This will be an opportunity to ensure that the Pope gets to know more about Nano.

2018 is a very significant year for the Presentation Sisters also for the following reasons:

- •It marks the 300th anniversary of the birth of Nano Nagle
- •An international Gathering of Presentation will take place in 2018
- •Phase 2 of the South Presentation development Nano Nagle Place -will be completed that year.
