Our future parish

This weekend we lay down another foundation stone for the parish community of the future. At Enniskeane Mass on Sunday, 51 children will enrol to prepare for their first celebration of the Sacrament of Penance (March) and their first time receiving Holy Communion (May). The boys and girls promise to get to know and love Jesus in a special way. Their parents renew the promise they gave at the child's baptism to help their child know God and be part of a living Christian Church community. Our parish - that's all of us – promises to support the children and their families through our prayer, our welcome and our encouragement.

Minding Church buildings

Every family needs a home. Every community needs a place to meet. Every parish needs places to worship, to build community and to be with God in a special way. The three churches in our parish are part of who we are and we are committed to minding them and keeping them in service of God and this community. Among the current needs to be addressed are:-

-- The heating system in Castletown Church has been fixed and hopefully will work until we completely upgrade it in the New Year.

-- The work to make Castletown Church accessible and welcoming will happen in the Spring.

-- The ceiling in the south porch of Enniskeane Church must be replaced. The Bell also needs attention.

-- We will also make provision for easier access and seating in part of Enniskeane Church for people with mobility difficulties and for wheelchair users.

-- Some of the paths in Enniskeane Cemetery need resurfacing.

-- We plan to provide external and accessible toilets in Enniskeane and to reorganise the parking area.

All of this work is necessary. It is being planned with care and with special attention to getting value for money for parishioners whose weekly donations and building fund contributions make this possible.

When these jobs will commence, a bit of inconvenience will be part of it but this will, hopefully, be minimal.
