A Redemptoristine from among us

Most of us have heard of the Redemptorist order of priests. They are probably best known in Ireland for the tradition of preaching parish missions. However, not many people around here have heard of the Redemptoristine order!

The Redemptoristines are a community of women religious who trace the founding of their order back to the same time (around 1700) and place that the Redemptorist fathers were founded by St Alphonsus Ligouri in Italy. Each religious community has its own 'rule' or mission or ethos. The Redemptoristines are an enclosed contemplative community of religious women. Their life is centred around the Liturgy of the Hours, the Eucharist, personal prayer and contemplation. Their monastery in Ireland is in Dublin.

Since a few days ago, our parish has established a special bond with this community. Máire O'Driscoll, Gortaleen, Enniskeane, who until recently was working as a primary school teacher, has joined the community as a novice. This means that she has begun with the Sisters a period of special prayer and discernment to confirm her belief that the Lord is calling her to be a Religious Sister for life.

As a parish community from which Máire has sprung, we accompany her in this time with our prayerful support. Máire is praying for us; let us pray with and for her, too.

We give thanks for this special blessing that the Lord has sent us; we also give thanks for the fertile seedbed of faith in her family home and among her friends where Máire's vocation has taken root.

We pray the Lord will give more people the courage to answer his call to service in priesthood and religious life.
