Booking Masses for a loved one

We have a tradition of praying for our loved ones when they die. Many people also like to have a Mass offered for their family member or relative. Traditionally, this was easy to arrange: we had lots of priests offering Masses and there were a lot more Masses in each church.

Until recently, we had little trouble in this parish in accommodating people's wishes for Months Mind Masses and Anniversary Masses on an individual basis. But this has changed because the number of funerals in the parish has increased a lot in recent years. Also, with families being spread apart due to emigration and moving to elsewhere in Ireland, families find they have to book the Masses and make arrangements farther ahead – making last-minute changes due to another funeral very difficult. So we have to make changes. They won't suit everyone but we have no choice.

We will continue to pray for people at all Masses. The weekend Masses will be shared by the people whose names are given to the Parish Office by Thursday midday each week (whether to mark a month, a year anniversary or longer after their death). They will be prayed for at each of the Masses offered in the parish on that weekend and their names will be read out as part of the Prayer of the Faithful. The parish will not take a booking for one of the Saturday or Sunday

Masses to be offered for just one person on the weekends from Feb 1st., 2017 onwards.

The weekday Masses on Tues, Thurs and Fri may be booked by one family for loved ones but we ask that you consider having Mass offered for more than one person on the same date (e.g both parents). Monday morning's Mass is usually offered for private intentions (e.g, a sick person).

(People who have already make bookings with the parish office do not need to change anything.)
