Holiest of Weeks

Lots of things are called holy. But this
week is the one use where it is most de-
served. The week is called Holy because
it revolves around the suffering, death and
resurrection of Jesus. These are the foun-
dation stones of the Christian life. Please
make a special effort to attend and pray at
the special ceremonies through these sa-
cred days. "He came that we may have
life and have it to the full."

Confession:

On Tues eve at 7.30pm in Enniskeane
Church we have a community celebration
of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. No
matter how long or why or what since the
last time, you are most welcome. Several
priests attending for the individual con-
fessions. [If you prefer the traditional
'confession box', this will be available on
Holy Saturday from 12 to 1pm.]

Holy Thursday:

One Mass; One Lord; One parish; —
one great act of thanksgiving. The Mass
of the Lord's Supper at 7.30pm at En-
niskeane Church.

A Holy Hour of Prayer at the Altar of
Repose will follow shortly after Mass.

Good Friday:

12noon: Ahiohill: Liturgy of the Lord's
Passion (and Holy Communion)

3pm: Castletown Kinneigh: Liturgy of
the Lord's Passion (and Communion)

7 pm: Stations of the Cross in 13
places across the parish. People are
asked to go to one of the 13 historic
places of prayer and then to make their
way to Enniskeane church for 7.50pm.

8 pm in Enniskeane Church the conclu-
sion of the Stations. This prayer time in-
cludes unveiling of our parish Good
Friday Cross.
