Parish Finances

The Parish Finance Committee and accountants FDC Group, Bandon, have recently signed off on the parish accounts for the year to Dec 31st, 2016.

The accounts testify to the ongoing generosity of parishioners, especially in the weekend collections and the Parish Building Fund. The offertory collections in 2016 amounted to €108,300 (€106,287 in 2015). During 2016 the amount contributed to the monthly Building Fund collections came to €39,160 (€35,960 in 2015). The parish received €7,927 in donations and bequests (€33,325 in 2015). These, along with €17,000 in the special collections, when added to smaller amounts, bring the total income for 2016 to €196,795 (€269,267 in 2015). [As well as the drop in once-off donations, we didn't process the refunds of income tax that year and between them these would account for €60k of a difference.

On the expenditure side, the parish spent €147,622 in 2016 compared with €148,747 in the previous year.

Works to repairing, maintaining and developing the churches, cemeteries, grounds and presbyteries accounted for nearly €60,000 of this (€19,000 in 2015). It includes the extension to Ahiohill cemetery, paths in Enniskeane cemetery, and essential maintenance of the churches.

Other significant sums include €13,172 for heat and light, €9,496 for insurance, €17,800 for wages, PRSI and USC for three part-time employees, €13,070 for church requisites (candles, altar supplies,

flowers etc) and the €17,000 from special collections sent on the various charities.

There was a surplus of \in 49,179 for the year transferred to parish reserves. This brought our balance at the bank in Dec 2016 to \in 240,114.

Already in 2017 the heating system at Castletown cost €36,320. The extension to the car park at Enniskeane Church has cost €43,000. We have also paid on €13,000 of levies due the diocese out of last year's collections.

Your ongoing kindness is appreciated.

Fr Pat Walsh has lived in our parish since his retirement from Rosscarbery Parish and we are very grateful for his ministry among us. He was ordained at Maynooth College 60 years ago this year.
