Refurbishment at Castletown

St. Joseph's Church was dedicated for worship in 1859. We are indebted to the people who made sacrifices to have the church built and then fitted out in a manner suitable for divine worship.

The recent works have included:-

- making the church fully accessible to all
- providing modern and accessible toilets
- replacing the front porch with an internal lobby area and laying a new plaza
- providing a space for parents and children (which will also serve as a meeting room)
- laying concrete paths all around the church
- providing a fire-proof boiler room
- additional lighting, new rails and gates
- painting the church inside and outside
- a CCTV security system with remote monitoring
- refurbishing historic items, incl the 19th Cent. painting of the Crucifixion.
