How much income tax and VAT have you paid so far this year? Do you ever feel that it would be great to put some of it to work locally?

And do you know how much tax the parish pays out -- from the money people put in the collection? Many people think that charities get VAT refunds -- but they don't.

So far this year, Enniskeane & Desertserges parish has paid out over €30,000 in VAT. The VAT bill for the builder's contract at Castletown Kinneigh church refurbishment stands at €22,115. That's a lot of collections.

But you can help get some of this back -- easily, confidentially and free.

Three easy steps:-

- 1. When you contribute to the collections in church use the numbered envelopes which the parish supplies for free.

 (ask for a box if you don't have one).
- 2. Fill a simple form (ask the parish for it) so that the parish can reclaim some of the tax you paid last year.
- 3. At year end, the parish submits a claim to revenue from the parish and some of the income tax is given to the parish.

We all have to pay tax - our community needs it -- but you shouldn't be paying tax on money you gave to the parish. Help get that back!

The new boxes of envelopes which are being distributed these days are for the year from Oct 1st until Sept next year.
