Payments to main contractor: $\in 133,429$ + $\in 18,013$ (VAT) - $\in 151,442$ Variations: $\in 26,294 + \in 3,550$ (VAT) =

variations: €26,294 + €3,550 (VAI) = €29,844

The variations include necessary items that were added after the contract. They include a new concrete footpath in the cemetery to left of the church, sealing of cracks on front gable, floor coverings and carpets, repairs to the bell and mountings, extra handrails, floodlights, new oil tank base, repairing and painting of roadside walls, etc.

In addition, further expenditure is incurred by the addition of extra items arranged directly by the parish and for which all figures are not yet to hand. These include the cost of security and CCTV at the church (\notin 4,303), repairs to the terrazzo floor in the sanctuary (\notin 2,900), seating (\notin 4,141), internal painting, extending heating to extension, etc.
