November Novena

The Novena of Masses for the Holy Souls is from Nov 2nd to the 10th and includes all Masses offered in the parish on those days. On Fri 10th, at 7.30pm in Enniskeane, our Novena of Masses concludes with a special Mass offered for the people whose funerals have taken place in the past 12 months in our parish.

Enrol your loved one in the Novena by submitting their names on a slip of paper and place it in one of the envelopes available in the church, with an offering, and return it to the church before Nov 2nd.

Where does it go?

A few people wondered as the collection at Mass was taken up! The weekly collections at Mass are lodged to the parish bank account. From there it is used to pay for heating, light, insurance, repairs and maintenance, parish newsletters, church supplies like candles, altar breads, security, payroll and a levy to the diocese and to care for retired priests. This year, a substantial part of the collections, along with the monthly building fund collection, is paying for the refurbishment of Castletown Church and the building of new toilets at Enniskeane Church.

Who pays the priests?

Nobody! The priests in a parish are not employed by anyone. They are self employed. Their income comes from voluntary donations of the people: the Parish Dues (at Station Mass time, at Easter and

at Christmas), one offering for Mass per day, the November offerings for Masses for the dead, and offerings at baptisms, weddings and funerals. The priests pays income tax and PRSI on all of these.
