### Our budget

Ever wonder what happens the money you place in the church collection each weekend? Here's a breakdown of our Expenditure and Income for April:-

Church Heating Ennisk / Ctown 2,650  
Payroll (3 people) 1,097  
Ahiohill heating 943  
Training of Funeral Ministers 880  
Security 683  
Grounds maint 500  
Office 360  
Candles 280  
Stationery 273  
Altar breads 187  
Refuse charge 140  
Property tax 64  
Bank charges 63  
Total spent €8,294

In April, the weekend collections in the three churches came to €7,450. From this, we pay 12% to the running costs of the diocese and 8% for the support of retired and ill priests. That one fifth is €1,490 and leaves the parish with €5,960. We received a donation of €700 which brought parish income to €6,660. So our accounts for April show a deficit of -€1,634.

The monthly Building Fund collection raised €3,080. Of this, €790 was paid as half of the cost of the stained glass repair at Castletown and the balance of €2,290 goes to the bank account.

In total for this month, we are €656 in the black. Many thanks for your generosity.
