Annual Cemetery Masses

Each summer, we celebrate Mass in each of the parish's churches during which we pray for all the people who are buried over the years in our local cemeteries. The dates for this year are as follows:-

Mon June 26th at 7.30pm: Mass at Ahiohill followed by prayers in Ahiohill Cemetery and then followed by prayers at Desert.

Tues June 27th at 7.30pm: Mass at Enniskeane followed by prayers in Enniskeane Cemetery and then prayers at Ballymoney Cemetery.

Thurs June 28th: Mass at Castletown Church followed by prayers in the cemetery and then followed by prayers at Kinneigh Cemetery. To help fund the maintenance costs of our parish cemeteries, a collection will be taken up at the Masses. Kindly let family members know the dates.

Pastoral Area Masses

Reminder: The priests of the neighbouring parishes in our area have drawn up a schedule of Masses for the summer break. This involves a slightly reduced number of Masses in the parishes and also involves the priests circulating between the churches to offer Mass. The rota will partially apply from June 23rd and will fully apply from Sat July 7th.

The summer schedule begins for our parish on Sat July 7th. We will have two Masses from the Enniskeane and Sunday 11am at Enniskeane.

Corpus Christi

The annual Corpus Christi procession takes place on Sunday after 12 Mass from Enniskeane Church to Gort Mhuire. All are welcome to walk with us. The First Holy Communion children will lead the procession and will collect at the south door at the top of the steps. The Confirmation children will collect at the north door facing the cemetery. Both sets of children will be assembled and coordinated by the Parish Assembly and the parents from the Do This In Memory group. All others should leave the Church by the main door. After the procession we will have refreshments and an Ice-cream tent with donations in aid of Down Syndrome Ireland. Baking can be dropped off to Gort Mhuire before mass.
