Canon Liam Leader

Please remember in prayer one of the priests of our diocese who died this week. Canon Liam Leader was ordained a priest in 1953 so he served the Lord and the people of this diocese for 65 years. A native of Carraig na bhFear, near Cork city, he spent most of his priesthood between there and Bantry. He retired as PP of St. Patrick's parish in 2005 but continued to serve the parish and even said Mass the morning he died. As a young priest he was responsible for establishing the Ardscoil post-primary school for boys in Bantry and was its principal teacher for 18 years. He also served a time as curate in Bandon parish.
