### Holy Souls Novena

The nine days of Masses offered for our people who have died and who have been enrolled in our Novena continues this week. Mass each day in Enniskeane (Mon-Fri at 10am); and from Monday to Thursday at Castletown at 7.30pm and at Ahiohill at 8.30pm. On Friday 9th at 7.30pm we have one parish Mass in Enniskeane Church at which we especially remember and pray for people whose funerals took place in our parish in the past year. Everyone is welcome to all the Masses. The Novena concludes with the two Vigil Masses on Sat 10th.

### Ahiohill Hall

Footpaths have been laid around Ahiohill Parish Hall and a new path created to provide safe access to the school grounds. This is to make the area safer for children being dropped off to the school next door and being collected. A safe path now exists between the traffic and the building -- allowing children to walk more safely (as opposed to walking in front of the vehicles).

A parking area is also reserved for school staff (please do not obstruct this).

Adults in vehicles are asked to take extra care as daylight gets shorter and be always mindful of children.
