## Ahiohill School Hall

The older building next to Ahiohill School was opened as a local national school in 1871 and served as a school until 1967 when a new school was built by the local Catholic Parish with grant aid from the Department of Education.

A Board of Management is responsible, on behalf of the patron, for the school. Until now, the parish with the aid of local volunteers has been responsible for the hall.

After consultation with local groups, the School Board of Management and the Parish have agreed to re-integrate the hall and the school as one school campus, while continuing to facilitate community access to the hall (subject to required criteria).

This will allow for a unified plan to be drawn up for the development of the school hall while providing for the expansion of facilities for the school.

From July 1st, 2019, the Board of Management of the School will include the hall in its remit.
