A new Shepherd

On Monday last, the successor to Bishop Buckley was named as Bishop-elect Fintan Gavin. He is a priest of the Dublin Archdiocese. He was born in Dublin in 1966. He is the second eldest of seven brothers and sisters.

He was ordained in 1991. Until Monday last he was Chancellor in the office of the Archdiocese of Dublin and Parish Chaplain in Ballymun Road.

We don't know yet when he will be ordained bishop and then begin his ministry as Bishop of Cork & Ross. Meanwhile, we extend a prayerful welcome to him and assure him of a warm reception whenever he gets to visit our parish.

August Music School

We invite young people from our community who have an interest in music and singing to attend a week-long summer school in Knockadoon, near the sea-side in east Cork. It promotes an appreciation of singing (especially contemporary songs for use in church) and offers tuition in a range of instruments. It is open to young people from the age of 13. It is residential in shared accommodation and is from August 11th to 17th. The cost per person for accommodation, all meals and materials is €120.
