Church Building

It's a blessing that the people who lived in our parish before us left us three lovely churches in which we can worship God and encounter one another. With this gift comes a responsibility on all of us to maintain them. One of the challenges in fulfilling that responsibility is that the buildings are old and built with old materials.

Early in the new year, work is needed to repair damage by age and rain in the upper area of the tower of Enniskeane Church. We are advised that the cement floor under the bell is in danger of collapsing if it isn't replaced. This work is not overly complex but access to the area in question makes it very time consuming. The work will involve closing the south porch of the church for at least five weeks. Other areas of the church will not be affected so normal schedules will continue.

The cost of the work will be met from the Parish Building Fund. Thanks for the ongoing generosity.
