Fr Anthony McCarthy grew up in Cork city and served as a priest of the Diocese of Dunkeld, Scotland, since his ordination until his recent death.

His remains have been brought back to Ireland and Mass will be celebrated for him at Enniskeane Church at 12n on Monday 28th October, (no morning Mass that day) and he will be buried afterwards with his parents in Enniskeane Cemetery. His mother was Margaret Hourihane from Cahir, Ballineen, and his late father Tim was a Kerry man who was a Garda in Ballineen before they moved to Cork. He is one of many of his generation from West Cork who became priests and served the Catholic parishes across Scotland. May he rest in peace.
