Works at Enniskeane Church

Essential maintenance work will be carried out inside the tower of Enniskeane Church this month. Works are scheduled to commence on Jan 7th and are expected to take four to six weeks. It involves inserting a new reinforced concrete floor high up in the tower, under the bell. A scaffold needs to be erected inside the tower so access to the church via the south door (at top of steps) will not be available during these works.
