Ordination to Diaconate

Wedding plans

Couples planning to get married in church have four essential steps to take:--- a recommended pre-marriage course (they're online now at www.accord.ie) - give at least three months notice to the civil registrar (https://www2.hse.ie/ births-deaths-and-marriages/) -- each person meets the priest of the parish you are living in at the time of the marriage to complete church pre-marriage papers at least two months before the wedding date - meet the priest who is celebrating the

meet the priest who is celebrating the Marriage ceremony with you to plan the ceremony (before you make any decisions about printing, music etc) Attendees: At this time the governments Covid plan restricts the number of guests at a wedding to 100. (Due to change in late Oct.)
