We learned of two deaths this week of priests of our diocese.

Canon Micheál Ó Dálaigh RIP
Canon Micheál died on Oct 5th. He was
the retired PP of Curraheen Road Parish,
Cork. Canon Micheál was a native of
Drimoleague and was ordained in 1971
in the same ceremony as Fr George
O'Mahony, Fr Denis O'Leary and Fr
Joe Coghlan. His first appointment was
as chaplain to St. Marie's of the Isle
Convent, Cork, for one year before
joining the staff of St. Finbarr's College,
Farranferris, in 1972.

He served as Curate in Dunmanway Parish from 1981 until 1983 when he was appointed President of Farranferris. He served as Parish Priest of St. Joseph's Parish Mayfield from 1990 until 2001 and then as parish priest of Curraheen Road from 2001 until 2013. He continued to serve in Curaheen Road until his retirement in 2015. Ar dheis Dé go raibh sé.

Archdeacon Liam O'Driscoll RIP Archdeacon Liam O'Driscoll died on Thursday. He retired from full-time ministry in Clogheen / Kerry Pike Parish earlier this year.

Archdeacon Liam was a native of Aughadown Parish and was ordained in 1967. He served in the parishes of Dunmanway, Crosshaven, The Cathe dral Parish, Glanmire and Clogheen/ Kerry Pike as well as on the Cork and Ross Peru Mission, as Chaplain to Cork University Hospital and on the staff of Farranferris College.

Archdeacon Liam also served as Diocesan Communications Director as well as Diocesan Designated Liaison Person from 2007-2012 and Deputy Designated Liaison Person from 2012-2019. He retired from full time ministry in 2021. May he now rest in the peace of the Lord.

### Re-opening

There was a good meeting of the Parish Assembly during the week at which plans for further re-opening were discussed. The government has said that it plans to lift most of the remaining restrictions on Oct 20th.

This will mean that we will be able to use all the pews and chairs in our churches once again. However, we will still take reasonable precautions: we will keep using the hand sanitisers on entry and exit irrespective of guidance. (We await further guidance from government and church authorities.)

When the limit of capacity is lifted, we will again have Mass in all three churches of our parish at weekends.

This also means that we need to revitalise the rotas for the various ministries and services which are part of our celebration of Mass. (During the restrictions, our rotas were comprised of some people from each church rota.)

During the next couple of weeks, look our for opportunities to be part of our ministry and service teams. There are opportunities for new gift bearers at the offertory (2nd class up), altar servers (3rd class to 6th), readers of the Prayer of the Faithful (4th class up), Minister of the Word for the second reading (5th class up and including post-primary), Minister of the Word for the First Reading (post-primary school, and adults), Minister of the Eucharist (TY students up and adults),

collector at Mass (post-primary school and adults). We need people on all these rotas for the three churches. Please tell us which church you would like to serve at.
