## Parish News!

Two parish-related things happening this week are about the future!

The parish church will be closed all this week to allow for essential maintenance work to happen inside. We are upgrading the lighting system in the church to low energy LED lighting which will lower the parish's energy costs and also help to contribute to minding our earth's resources. At the same time, we are running internal network cabling which will replace the temporary cables we ran during the lock-down last year. This will help us to provide a better quality live stream to the online part of our community.

Also this week, almost all the priests in appointments in the diocese are attending a gathering with Bishop Fintan on the topic "Stepping stones for a new future". This will involve four days of prayer, reflection, discussion, listening, thinking, probably debating ... topics such as what will the diocese be like in a few years when many parishes won't have a resident priest. How do priests respond to the challenges in proclaiming the Gospel in a changing culture? How

can we better collaborate with parishioners?

Priests won't answer all the questions in four days! This is the beginning of a process which will also involve in-depth discussion with parishioners (when the pandemic allows this to happen). Do keep this gathering in your prayer this week. Hopefully by the end of the week, we'll have more light on the mission of the diocese and more light inside the church building in Enniskeane! All this means that the regular weekday Masses in the parish (and in all parishes) will not be celebrated from Monday to Thursday. Friday morning's 10am mass will be celebrated in Castletown Kinneigh Church.

## Funeral Ministry Team

Since the start of the pandemic, our Parish Funeral Ministry Team was unable to minister to the bereaved due the restrictions. These restrictions have now been lifted and we can all resume our ministry but with essential safeguards in place. A meeting of the Parish Funeral Ministry Team will take place in the Gort Mhuire Centre, Ballineen, on Saturday Dec 4th from 1pm to 3pm. This is to recommence the ministry of the Team and to discuss the new resources recently published by the diocese. The Funeral Ministry Team from Murragh and Templemartin Parish will also attend. We'll begin with a light lunch at 1pm.
