Day for Consecrated Life

To mark the Day for Consecrated Life, Bishop Fintan invited members of religious communities in the diocese to join him online in praying Evening Prayer on Wednesday Feb. 2nd at 5pm.

The Vespers liturgy was celebrated at St. Finbarr's Church, Dunbar St., Cork, where a number of young religious women and men joined Bishop Fintan in a prayer that was streamed online to all religious houses in the diocese – and across the world.

The Day for Consecrated Life gives thanks for the ministry and service of women and men who have consecrated their lives to service of God and his people as religious order priests, women and men who are missionaries, as well as women and men who serve as religious sisters and brothers in a range of ministries at home. Vespers is the Evening Prayer of the Divine Office — the daily prayer of the church which ordained and consecrated women and men pray If you would like to see the service it is available on www.corkandross.org.
