Lent 2022 - A better tomorrow

This Lent, we are asked to think about communities who were already facing huge challenges due to drought and food shortages, caused by climate change, that were then were further impacted by Covid-19. For example in Zimbabwe, in 2020, 75 per cent of rural households faced moderate to severe food scarcity, compared to 42 per cent in 2019. Covid-19 has impacted people's livelihoods and access to education and food security.

With your support, Trócaire, works with marginalised communities living in poverty in Zimbabwe. They work with rural communities to help improve food production. They also work with women to protect them from violence and encourage them to have a stronger voice. Your donations help provide life-changing support to some of the world's poorest peoples.

Prayer for Ukraine

In a message to parishes, Bishop Fintan Gavin asks for prayers for peace in Ukraine and for Ukrainian people. "As the reality of war in the Ukraine deepens and innocent lives are threatened and lost, I invite the people of the Diocese and all people of good will to join me in praying for the people in Ukraine.

We stand in solidarity with all Ukrainian people living among us in the Diocese of Cork and Ross as well as with people from here who have made Ukraine their home. We pray for an end to war and a restoration of peace.

I also encourage you to take up Pope Francis invitation to make Ash Wednesday a day of prayer and fasting for peace in Ukraine."
